Clerk Tingleff called the roll. President Caldwell led a brief meditation.

Trustee Cragg moved that the minutes of the meeting of October 25, 1971, be approved as prepared; seconded by Trustees Carlson and Forrest and passed unanimously.

President Caldwell introduced Mr. John Osborn, a prospective appointee to the Board of Appeals of the Village of North Barrington.

#### VILLAGE OFFICERS

TREASURER - Treasurer Ypelaar presented a Treasurer's Report for the period ending October 31, 1971, showing balances as follows:

Trustee Saville moved adoption of the Treasurer's Report; seconded by Trustee Carlson.

The President declared the motion carried.

Treasurer Ypelaar then presented the "Flash Report" of receipts and expenditures for the period November 1 through 22, and a comparison of expenditures vs. budget showing expenditures approved and paid through October 31, 1971.

CLERK - Clerk Tingleff presented four vouchers for payment from the general corporate fund totaling \$3,534.79. Trustee Forrest moved to approve payment; seconded by Trustee Saville. While concurring with approval of the vouchers, Page 2 Minutes of 11/22/71

the President indicated his intention of delaying signing and forwarding payment on one of them, covering a \$969.00 BACOG assessment, until the basis of final payment of Barton-Aschman by BACOG had been clarified.

The President declared the motion carried.

BOARD OF APPEALS - Chairman Hammer presented the certified minutes of the Board of Appeals meeting of November 19, 1971, containing two resolutions passed by them. The first resolution recommended that the Board of Trustees grant a Zoning Variation to permit additions to the existing conforming residence of Eberhard and Ruth Burchert, 566 Brookside Road. After discussion, Trustee Forrest moved that the Board of Trustees concur with the recommendation of the Board of Appeals and direct that an Ordinance be prepared granting the recommended variation; seconded by Trustee Saville and passed unanimously.

The second resolution recommended that the Board of Trustees grant a Zoning Variation to permit additions to the non-conforming residence of H. S. and Virginia J. FitzGibbon, 102 Mohawk Drive. After discussion, Trustee Forrest moved that the Board of Trustees concur with the recommendation of the Board of Appeals and direct that an Ordinance be prepared granting the recommended variation; seconded by Trustee Carlson and passed unanimously.

Chairman Hammer then presented the certified minutes of the Board of Appeals meeting of October 4, 1971, which was continued on October 27, 1971, containing a resolution passed by them recommending that the Board of Trustees deny a variation from the Zoning Ordinance to permit the erection of a single family residence by James W. and Suzanne Beile on Lot 26 in Grandview Estates First Addition (northeast corner of Route 59 and Miller Road). No one appeared for the petitioner. After discussion, Trustee Forrest moved that the Board of Trustees concur with the recommendation of the Board of Appeals and deny the variation; seconded by Trustee Saville and passed unanimously.

#### COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Planning and Zoning - Trustee Forrest reported that a letter had been received from the Village of Deer Park stating that the so-called Brandel property had been turned over to a low density country club plan; that a public hearing would be held on December 15, 1971, concerning property just south of the Village of Barrington being annexed to the Village and rezoned to permit construction of a shopping center; that in the BACOG area of 80 square miles, all villages have Comprehensive Plans of relatively recent date with the exception of Barrington; and that it had been reported in the Lake Zurich newspaper that Wight Consulting Engineers had recommended that the Village of Lake Zurich seek approval of the transfer of waste water from the Dearborn Chemical plant to the Northwest sewage plant, the effluent from which flows through North Barrington. After discussion of this last matter, Trustee Forrest moved that President Caldwell be authorized to communicate with the Village of Lake Zurich and the Illinois Pollution Control Board stating North Barrington's desire for an upgrading of this Northwest

sewage plant, not the premature transfer of more waste water to it; seconded by Trustee Saville and passed unanimously.

#### OLD BUSINESS

President Caldwell stated that since a three-fourths vote was needed to pass proposed Ordinance No. 133, it would be deferred until the December meeting.

President Caldwell showed a Lake County Highway map on which the collector road bisecting the Village of North Barrington had been removed; announced that additional communications had been received from the Cook County Council of Government and the Chicago and North Western Railway with regard to the Chicago Area Transportation Study Interim Plan and Program and that Trustee Talbot would continue to represent the Village of North Barrington on this matter; and announced that he had received the published edition of the Recommended Comprehensive Planning Policies for the Barrington, Illinois, Area.

#### NEW BUSINESS

President Caldwell brought up the matter of the meeting date for December. After discussion, Trustee Cragg moved that the regular December meeting of the Board of Trustees be held on December 20, 1971, in the North Barrington School at 8:00 P. M., instead of December 27, 1971, as previously scheduled, and that the required public notice of the change be given; seconded by Trustee Saville and passed unanimously.

At 9:10 P. M. Trustee Saville moved that the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously. The Board then went into executive session.
