Trustee Saville moved that the minutes of the meeting of November 22, 1971, be approved as prepared; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

President Caldwell presented proposed Resolution No. 353 confirming his appointment of John Osborn as a member of the Board of Appeals of the Village of North Barrington. Trustee Forrest moved adoption of Resolution No. 353; seconded by Trustee Saville and passed unanimously. Clerk Tingleff then administered the oath of office to Mr. Osborn.

Trustee Saville moved that the Board of Trustees concur with the recommendation of the Plan Commission and direct that an ordinance be prepared for consideration at the next meeting vacating that portion of Sunset Drive north of the north line of Brookside Road and east of the east line of Illinois Highway 59 right of way, as requested in the petition; seconded by Trustee Cragg.
