Clerk Tingleff called the roll. President Caldwell announced that while Trustee Boynton was enjoying a vacation in the South, Trustee Saville was absent as a result of a heart attack he suffered two weeks ago, but was home now and resting comfortably. President Caldwell led a brief meditation.

Trustee Forrest moved that the minutes of the meeting of December 20, 1971, be approved as prepared; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

President Caldwell presented proposed Resolution No. 354 confirming his reappointment of Bernard J. Ypelaar as Treasurer of the Village of North Barrington. Trustee Cragg moved adoption of Resolution No. 354; seconded by Trustee Carlson and passed unanimously.

VILLAGE OFFICERS

TREASURER - Treasurer Ypelaar presented a Treasurer's Report for the period ending December 31, 1971, showing balances as follows:

The President declared the motion carried.

Treasurer Ypelaar then presented a comparison of expenditures approved and paid through December 31, 1971, vs. budget for the same period, a comparison and analysis of corporate fund receipts for the nine months ended December 31 between fiscal years 1971 and 1972, and the "Flash Report" of receipts and expenditures for the period January 1 through 21.

Page 2 Minutes of 1/24/72

<u>CLERK</u> - Clerk Tingleff presented three vouchers for payment from the general corporate fund totaling \$7,287.94. Trustee Forrest moved to approve payment; seconded by Trustee Carlson.

The President declared the motion carried.

PLAN COMMISSION - In the absence of Chairman Clarke, President Caldwell presented and reviewed the minutes of a reconvened meeting of the Plan Commission held on January 6, 1972. A discussion was held concerning the third item in the minutes, the Barton-Aschman Recommended Comprehensive Planning Policies on which the Plan Commission had made three recommendations. The consensus of the Trustees was to concur with each of the recommendations made and the discussion continued with Trustee Forrest reading a portion of his letter of January 24, 1972, to President Caldwell. Trustee Forrest then moved that the Board of Trustees:

- (1) concur with points 3a, 3b, and 3c as contained in the Plan Commission minutes of their meeting of January 6, 1972;
- (2) call for extreme caution in accepting densities of one or more units per acre outside the Village of Barrington;
- (3) recognize that the report is <u>not</u> a comprehensive plan; and
- (4) accept it as consultant's recommendations and not as a binding plan, and note that the above reservations are not in any way negative to the work of BACOG or to the document;

seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

ROADS - Superintendent Wileman presented a bill for the 1971 MFT Maintenance Program for \$14,244.34, which he recommended be approved stating that the work was complete and the bill correct. Trustee Talbot moved to approve payment of \$14,244.34 from the MFT Fund; seconded by Trustee Carlson.

The President declared the motion carried.

Superintendent Wileman also reported that the usual complaints had been received concerning the condition of roads in the Village due to ice and snow; that he had been requested to consider another Village Engineer which would be done after the 1972 MFT work was completed if still desired; that the snow plowing contract still was not signed by the Village since no

insurance certificate had been received; and that he felt a request would be forthcoming from Biltmore Country Club with regard to raising the level of Signal Hill Road at the south end of Honey Lake.

COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Finance and Law - Trustee Cragg announced that letters would be going out to department heads this week concerning budget requests for the next fiscal year which begins April 1, 1972. These requests are to be prepared by quarters and returned to him by February 22, 1972.

<u>Planning and Zoning</u> - Trustee Forrest announced that he had appeared before the Lake Zurich Plan Commission opposing a change in zoning at the southwest corner of Routes 12 and 22.

OLD BUSINESS

Trustee Cragg moved that a typographical error in the minutes of Autust 30, 1971, under the headings of Plan Commission (page 2) and New Business (page 3) be corrected to refer to the ordinance designating a Village Map as Ordinance No. 131A and that the said Ordinance be redesignated on its face as Ordinance No. 131A; seconded by Trustee Talbot and passed unanimously.

President Caldwell announced that the Lake County Planned Development Ordinance was passed on January 11, 1972, and Trustee Forrest commended President Caldwell for his help and persistence in this matter during the last six months.

President Caldwell stated that a letter had been received from the Assistant Attorney General stating that a complaint had been filed before the Pollution Control Board on behalf of the Environmental Protection Agency against the Village of Lake Zurich with regard to the alleged pollution of the creek running through the Village of North Barrington, and that he had offered his testimony and also that of three residents along the creek.

NEW BUSINESS

President Caldwell brought up the matter of a vehicle license enforcement deadline, in view of the State having announced that failure to display 1972 plates would not incur prosecution until after February 14, 1972. After discussion, Trustee Talbot moved that enforcement of the regulation to have and display a 1972 Village of North Barrington vehicle license be withheld until February 15, 1972, and that the Police Department be directed to enforce strictly the terms of the Ordinance on and after that date; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

At 9:35 P. M. Trustee Cragg moved that the meeting be adjourned; seconded by Trustee Carlson and passed unanimously.
