The President declared a quorum present and opened the meeting.

Trustee Schunk moved that the minutes of the December 30, 1963 meeting be approved as written - seconded by Trustee Lafferty and passed unanimously.

OFFICERS' REPORTS:

TREASURER: Mr. Martin Keagy reported balances as follows:

Mr. Keagy also reported he had received a call from a representative of the Insurance Company relative to an audit of Village roads and personnel. Information supplied over the telephone appeared to satisfy the Insurance Company representative.

VILLAGE CLERK: The clerk presented invoices for approval totaling \$455.29 - (list attached.) Trustee Forrest moved for approval - seconded by Trustee Krumlinde and passed unanimously.

POLICE: Chief Roy E. Swacha reported the following complaints processed:

Theft of wheels and tires from a car parked in front of North Barrington School.

Car accident at Signal Hill and Rt. 59.

Alleged tire slashing.

Officers on patrol were of assistance in incidents involving an hysterical teenager (family trouble) - a sick person needing emergency care - and an intoxicated driver giving a State Police Officer difficulty.

<u>BUILDING OFFICER:</u> Deputy Building Officer Mrs. R. J. Kerr reported one building permit in process - \$126.00.

ROADS: Mr. G. E. Davis - No report.

FIRE: No report.

HEALTH OFFICER: The President reported for the Health Officer -

Three existing complaints on new septic systems: Two on which the Bonding Company is involved and one on which a new plan is being prepared by a professional sanitary engineer.

Complaints have been received on septic systems of two older homes - the Kreuger residence at 297 Homewood Lane - and the Walsh residence at 253 Biltmore Drive. Both are under investigation.

North Barrington School has requested bids on a chlorination system. Relative to the complaint filed by Mr. and Mrs. J. A. Denker of 301 Glen Circle, advice has been received from both the State and the County that there is no validity to the complaint at this time.

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT: The President reported he, together with Mr. Lyle Palmer, had met with Mr. John Clarke of Clarke Outdoor Spraying. A trip was made through the entire Village, including the recently annexed area, and a very careful study made for the mosquito abatement program for the coming year.

FINANCE & LAW: Trustee Urick advised he will call a meeting of the Finance Committee as soon as all departmental budgets have been received.

PLANNING & ZONING: The President advised he had vetoed Ordinance No. 54 vacating a portion of Rustic Drive on the grounds that all adjacent land owners had not been requested to concur in the vacation. Trustee Krumlinde moved that Ordinance No. 54 be allowed to stand as approved by the Board on December 30, 1963, seconded by Trustee Urick.

After discussion Trustee Forrest moved that the Village join with South Barrington and the other municipalities as "friends of the court" in a petition for rehearing of the case. Seconded by Trustee Urick and passed unanimously.


