Clerk Tingleff called the roll; President Caldwell led a brief meditation.

Trustee Boynton moved that the minutes of the meeting of May 24, 1971, be approved as prepared; seconded by Trustee Carlson and passed unanimously.

#### VILLAGE OFFICERS

TREASURER - Treasurer Ypelaar presented a Treasurer's Report for the period ending May 31, 1971, showing balances as follows:

Treasurer Ypelaar pointed out that while the total disbursements shown were correct, an error in distribution between Administrative and Office and the Police Departments was made and would be corrected on the next report. Trustee Boynton moved adoption of the Treasurer's Report; seconded by Trustee Talbot.

The President declared the motion carried.

Treasurer Ypelaar then presented the "Flash Report" of receipts and expenditures for the period June 1 through June 25.

<u>CLERK</u> - Clerk Tingleff presented three vouchers for payment from the general corporate fund totaling \$2,761.02. Trustee Boynton moved to approve payment; seconded by Trustee Saville.

The President declared the motion carried.

Clerk Tingleff then presented one voucher for payment from the MFT fund for \$11.00. Trustee Saville moved to approve payment; seconded by Trustee Carlson.

Nays: None

Absent: Trustee Forrest

The President declared the motion carried.

Clerk Tingleff then presented Audit Report No. 7 which was received from the State of Illinois covering the receipt and disbursement of Motor Fuel Tax Funds by the Village of North Barrington for the period January 1, 1969, through December 31, 1969. Trustee Boynton moved that the Board of Trustees receive and file this report; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

ROADS - Superintendent Wileman stated that bids from three firms had been received on the complete list of projects suggested by Wight Consulting Engineers to be incorporated in the 1971 MFT Contract Maintenance Program. The bids were: Liberty Asphalt, Grayslake - \$14,941.80; Skokie Valley Asphalt, Des Plaines - \$16,604.35; and H. J. Curran, Crystal Lake - \$17,305.02. Superintendent Wileman recommended the acceptance of the bid from Liberty Asphalt and stated that this was also the recommendation of Wight Consulting Engineers. He also stated that projected funds will cover the work to be done.

Trustee Forrest was present for the remainder of the meeting.

Trustee Talbot moved to accept the bid from Liberty Asphalt and award them the contract for the 1971 MFT Contract Maintenance Program and to authorize the signing of the necessary MFT contract documents; seconded by Trustee Cragg.

The President declared the motion carried.

<u>PLAN COMMISSION</u> - Chairman Clarke read the minutes of the last meeting of the Plan Commission which was held on June 1, 1971, and commented on them briefly. President Caldwell added that another review of the Village map had been held with Lake County Regional Planning Commission and it was back in their hands for further corrections, with another proof to be submitted prior to final acceptance.

BUILDING AND ZONING - Officer Ray announced that the construction at Honey Lake Road and Signal Hill Road had been investigated and that a lake was being constructed, but that this property was definitely not within the

Village boundaries. He also stated that with regard to the flooding at 598 and 586 Golfview, which he had been given the authority to investigate and study with the assistance of the Village consulting engineers, he had met with and received communications from Wight Consulting Engineers. It has been concluded that the situation is definitely not caused by the Village of North Barrington and Trustee Forrest suggested that the Village provide guidelines to the residents and the Country Club, share the Wight correspondence with them and encourage them to take care of the matter. The other Trustees concurred with this suggestion.

#### COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD

Parks and Auxiliary Services - Trustee Carlson announced that with the exception of one policy, which does not expire for another year, and Workman's Compensation, which is assigned to a company by the State, all of the Village insurance policies were now with one local agent.

Health and Sanitation - Trustee Saville announced that there had been seven new septic system violation complaints during the past month and then explained the dye testing process used to show a system failure. He then brought up the problem of the excess discharge from the Lake Zurich sewage treatment plant which comes down the creek and into North Barrington. Trustee Saville then moved that, in recognition of complaints received from our citizens as to the apparent deterioration of the creek and known tests that have been made, letters of protest be sent to the Lake Zurich Village authorities, the County, the State Pollution Control Board, and the State Environmental Protective Agency, drawing the situation to their attention and urgently requesting action to contain and alleviate it; seconded by Trustee Cragg and passed unanimously.

<u>Planning and Zoning</u> - Trustee Forrest stated his favorable reaction to the forthcoming land use provisions to be announced in the Barton-Aschman study and urged the Plan Commission, the Board of Appeals and the Board of Trustees of the Village of North Barrington not to change the minimum lot sizes in the Village as requests are made except in hardship cases.

#### OLD BUSINESS

President Caldwell announced that a lawsuit was still in progress against the Village of North Barrington by Kenneth Schmid. Trustee Cragg moved that the Village Attorney be authorized to file a motion for summary dismissal of the case and to represent on behalf of the Village its willingness to provide for and allow a total of seven residences on the Schmid property, this being the maximum number authorized by deed covenant restrictions applicable to the property; seconded by Trustee Boynton.

The President declared the motion carried.

#### NEW BUSINESS

President Caldwell presented proposed Ordinance No. 124, a road vacation ordinance. He then showed a map pointing out the areas involved, explained the policy on fees for vacation of roads which the Village has, and recommended the waiving of the fee in this instance since a portion of the land will be deeded to the Village. Trustee Talbot moved adoption of Ordinance No. 124; seconded by Trustee Carlson.

The President declared the motion carried.

Trustee Forrest presented a new Lake County Highway Map which he had recently received and after discussion moved that the matter be referred to the Plan Commission for action concerning the Village policy; seconded by Trustee Talbot and passed unanimously.

President Caldwell brought up the matter of meeting dates for July and August and after discussion it was decided to adjourn tonight's meeting to July 12, 1971, at 8:00 P. M. in the North Barrington School and to keep the regular July meeting of the Board of Trustees on July 26, 1971, as scheduled. Trustee Forrest moved that the regular August meeting of the Board of Trustees be held on August 30, 1971, in the North Barrington School at 8:00 P. M., instead of August 23, 1971, as previously scheduled, and that the required public notice of the change be given; seconded by Trustee Talbot and passed unanimously.

At 9:30 P. M. Trustee Talbot moved that the meeting be adjourned to July 12, 1971, at 8:00 P. M. in the North Barrington School; seconded by Trustee Boynton and passed unanimously. The Board then went into executive session.
