Trustee Schulke moved to approve the minutes of the August 28, 1967 meeting - seconded by Trustee Davis and passed unanimously.

In his opening remarks President Anderson spoke of the passing of Trustee Martin Keagy, who for many years had served on the Village staff as Treasurer and later as Trustee. Remembrance of him was expressed in the invocation.

The President declared the motion carried.

Treasurer Gerry reported receipt of the Certified Audit Report from Putta & Kelsey - with bill for \$175.00. After discussion the Audit Report was referred to the Trustees Committee on Finance and Law for review and presentation at the next Board meeting, at which time the bill for \$175.00 will be

submitted for payment.

Because of the small amount involved - (\$25.00) - and the inactivity of the account, Treasurer Gerry recommended that the Board consider abolishing the Petty Cash Account, and that the amount be transferred to the Corporate Fund. After discussion Trustee Schulke so moved - seconded by Trustee Forrest and passed unanimously.

The President declared the motion carried. (Copy of details attached to these minutes.)

The clerk submitted Rental Agreement for school facilities at the same rate and conditions for the period September 25, 1967 through November, 1968. After discussion the President was authorized to execute the Rental Agreement with the school administration for the 1967/1968 period.

<u>POLICE:</u> Chief Roy E. Svacha reported complaints and incidents processed as follows:

HEALTH OFFICER: The President advised that Dr. Thomas J. Olson, a dentist residing in the Village, had consented to serve the Village as Health Officer and requested Board ratification of the appointment. Trustee Cutler moved to confirm the President's appointment of Dr. Thomas J. Olson as Health Officer for the Village - seconded by Trustee Davis and passed unanimously.

The President advised that a Deputy Health Officer is being considered and will be presented for ratification shortly.

<u>ROADS:</u> The President advised that Superintendent of Roads C. M. Newgent reported -

As authorized at the August 28, 1967 meeting, a contract for road maintenance work has been executed with the lowest bidder - Liberty Asphalt Products Inc., - in amount \$4,330.02. After discussion the President requested Board ratification of the contract with Liberty Asphalt Products Inc., - - Trustee Davis so moved - seconded by Trustee Cutler -

By roll call vote: AYES - Trustees Cutler, Davis, Forrest and Schulke
NAYS - None
ABSENT - Trustee Krumlinde.

The President discussed the snow plowing and removal program for the coming season and requested authority to extend the present agreement dated November 21, 1967 to cover the period November 1, 1967 to July 1, 1968 with all other conditions remaining unchanged. Trustee Davis so moved - seconded by Trustee Schulke -

ABSENT - Trustee Krumlinde.

The President declared the motion carried.

Trustee Krumlinde entered the meeting.

MOSQUITO ABATEMENT - No report.

FIRE COMMISSIONER - New stickers giving police and fire numbers are ready for distribution.

<u>PARKS & AUXILIARY SERVICES:</u> The President advised that it has been necessary to remove more diseased trees this year than ever before.

A suspected oak tree on Village right-of-way on North Signal Hill Road has been examined but does not have Oak Wilt. Mr. Ken Schmid of North Signal Hill Road volunteered to defray the expense of treatment in an effort to save the tree.

<u>PLAN COMMISSION:</u> The Board discussed the petition of Mr. and Mrs. Denker, Mr. and Mrs. Pertl, and Dr. and Mrs. Olson to vacate a portion of Hawthorne Road. After discussion it was consensus of the Board to defer action on the vacation pending legal determination of the necessity for notification to another owner of property abutting both Hawthorne Road and Miller Road and also for investigation of the payment for the vacation.

BOARD OF APPEALS: The President advised that a public hearing is scheduled for Thursday, September 28, 1967 - 8:00 P.M. - North Barrington School to hear testimony on the petition of Alice R. Campbell to subdivide her property.

TRUSTEES COMMITTEES:

FINANCE & LAW: No report.

POLICE, FIRE & PUBLIC SAFETY: The President advised that on the recommendation of Chief R. E. Svacha, Messrs. Harry W. Carlson Jr., H. Stewart FitzGibbon Jr., and Lloyd M. Wileman have been appointed Special Policemen and submitted Resolution No. 226 appointing Messrs. Carlson, FitzGibbon and Wileman. Trustee Schulke moved to confirm the President's appointment of Messrs. Carlson, FitzGibbon and adoption of Resolution No. 226 - seconded by Trustee Cutler - and passed unanimously.

On the recommendation of Chief R. E. Svacha the President submitted Resolution No. 227 appointing Special Police Officer Nestor J. Motluck to the Regular Police Force. Trustee Forrest moved to confirm the President's appointment and the adoption of Resolution No. 227 - seconded by Trustee Schulke and passed unanimously.

The President advised he has been working with school officials and state representatives on getting a signal light installed at Highway 59 and Miller Road and has received very favorable help within the past week or ten days.

BUILDING REGULATIONS

HEALTH & SANITATION - The President advised that he and Building Officer R. C. Emrick spent some time with the Lake County Health Department personnel. It has been recommended that Village regulations be amended to require at least two soil borings, which more accurately tell the type of soil and whether or not a satisfactory septic installation is possible than percolation tests. After discussion the matter was referred to the Trustees Committee on Health and Sanitation for consideration and recommendation to the Board.

GENERAL:

Discussion on the appointment of a trustee to succeed the late Martin Keagy was held over to the next Board meeting.

The President discussed the drainage problem which Mr. Don Lutz has reported on his property at 460 North Hill Drive, and the estimate of \$1,979.20 to correct the problem. After discussion the matter was referred to the Trustees Committee on Roads and Public Utilities.

The President then asked if there was any more business to be reviewed. Mrs. Eva Schwartzman advised she wished to discuss Mr. J. A. Denker's application for utilities to a home he is building on Edgewood Lane k-a road dedicated but not built. The President asked what Mrs. Schwartzman's connection was with the property involved and Mrs. Schwartzman replied she was an attorney representing Mr. and Mrs. J. A. Denker. After brief discussion the Board was unanimous in confirming information already given to Mr. Denker by the President that the matter must first be presented to the Plan Commission for consideration before it can be brought before the Board of Trustees. Mrs. Schwartzman agreed to make agrangements to meet with the Plan Commission.
