These provided that congress should have authority to appoint a "committee of the states," to consist of one delegate from each state, to sit in the recess of congress. The president of the congress came the nearest to being an executive head. But he and the "committee of the states" and several other boards and committees exercised their authority more or less jointly.

Glow Worms Set Trap To Catch Food Supply Most people are acquainted with the glow worm—the insect whose phosphorescent light is frequently seen in country lanes. In Waltham, North Island, New Zealand, there is a cave called the Glow-Worm cave where the insects live under shelter. By the light of a strong torch one can see the worms overhead, with little threads which look like strings of seed pearls hanging from them. The strings are sticky and are the means of catching mosquitoes and other tiny insects, which, attracted by the glow worm's light, fly to their doom.

United States Is Third in Production of Gold One-half of the gold produced in the world is mined in South Africa annually. Another 20 per cent is mined in colonies of Great Britain, chiefly in Canada. The United States is third in place, says an exchange. The mines are principally in a range of hills near Johannesburg in an area 53 miles long and two to five miles wide. There is found the "reef," which means what it does on the seashore—a layer of rock three to three feet wide hidden in the reef, or rock layer. Then in some places the lake was lifted into hills and the layer of gold rock was tipped into the heart of the hills. It lies at an angle 20 to 40 degrees, buried a mile deep in places, outcropping here and there and nobody knows how far it extends beyond the present explored areas.
