facts. In the event government aid is obtained, it will be possible to extend the time of payment for fifteen or more years. An effort will be made to postpone the payment on account of principal for a few years. While we are not able at this time to give exact quotations as to the cost of improvement, we can be assured that the average cost of this improvement will be substantially less than \$100 per running foot. There will necessarily be some difference in the rate of assessment. Property that does not receive a permanent new improvement will pay less than the property which does receive a permanent improvement. Property which has not at the present time an outlet, such as the Jewel Tea subdivision, will be selected to pay its proper outlet charge. When this outlet charge spreads over a period of at least fifteen years, taxpayers can be assured that the expense of this sewer system on a fifty foot lot can be met annually for less than a five dollar bill and it may be possible to postpone the payment of principal for a few years. In the certain sections of the village require additional improvements, these sections will have to bear the cost of any separate improvements required.

We have attempted briefly to give taxpayers the most important facts with reference to this sewer. We are confident that other taxpayers would feel as we do that this opportunity should not be permitted to go by. If it is possible to get government aid and thereby make this saving, we feel that other taxpayers will be in accord with us in believing that this is the proper action.

We further desire to assure the taxpayers that the village of Barrington at this time is ably represented by lawyers and engineers who are thoroughly acquainted with all phases of municipal and special assessment work and sewage problems. There should not be any reasonable fear of the village taking a wrong step through lack of proper legal and engineering advice.

We desire to assure the people of Barrington that no member of the village board is taking an arbitrary attitude in connection with sewer problem. If our people do not desire improvement at this time, we are willing to abide by their wishes. If agreed, we will be glad to call another public hearing on this project.
