Lockup. - the same to be 12 x 14 feet in
size. Sills to be 6 x 6 inches, the outside
walls to be built with 2 x 6 scantling laid
flatwise on said sills and each one
to be thoroughly spiked with at least
double 10 pm. Nails as each is laid upon
the other, and said walls to be 8 feet
high, with 2 partitions inside to be laid
up with 2 x 4 scantling, the same as the
outside walls thoroughly spiked together
the floors both upper and lower to be
laid with 2 inch plank and double
with suitable doors & windows for
ventilation the same to be built by a
Committee appointed by this board and
to be accepted and approved by them
when completed.
