

An Ordinance Amending an Ordinance and Amendments thereto concerning "Drum Shops" in the Village of Barrington.

Be it Ordained by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Barrington in the Counties of Cook and Lake and State of Illinois

Section I: That said Ordinance and amendments thereto of the Village of Barrington concerning "Drum Shops" be and the same is hereby amended by adding thereto Section Six and one half said section to read as follows.

Section 6 1/2 All Windows fronting upon any public street within the Village of Barrington in any room or place maintained as a drum shop or house wherein liquors are sold shall be kept free from all obstructions, from screens, curtains or other material between the hours of 10 P.M. and 5 A.M. and at all other times when said drum shops are closed, in such a manner that the entire bar and interior of said room or place so maintained as a drum shop may be easily viewed from the sidewalk in front and upon the side thereof.

Whoever shall violate this section shall be upon conviction be fined not less than Ten dollars (\$10⁰⁰) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200⁰⁰) for each offence.

Section II: This Ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage.
