Official Board Meetings of M. & Church Barrington Ill Commencing how 1st 1899

Minutes of special meeting of the Official Board of the Barrington M.E.Church, held at the church parlors on Tuesday evening, November 14th.1899, with Rev. J. B. Robinson in the chair. Members present, Messrs. R. Nightingale, H.A.Harnden, Wm.Collen, E.L.Wilmer, P.Houghtaling, Mrs. M.Wilmer and Miss C.E.Kingsley.

Motion was made and carried that the cost of moving Dr. Robinson's goods from Rockford,
Ill., amounting to \$19.74, be paid. The amount was then paid to him by the Treasurer.

Motion was made and carried i structing the Treasurer to pay, with the first money coming into his hands, the second installment of the water tax, amounting to \$15.68.

The Treasurer's report for the year ending October 1899, showing receipts amounting to \$151.10, expenditures \$139.24,- balance \$11.86,- was read and approved.

It was moved and carried that Mr. P. Houghtaling be hired as sexton for the ensuing year on the following terms, which were accepted by him, viz:

"It is agreed that Peter Houghtaling shall do all the sexton's or janitor's work for the M.E.Church at regular and Epworth League meetings, and to light the lamp on the church steps when services are being held on Sunday nights and Thursday nights: said Sexton to receive for such services one dollar and fifty cents (\$1.50) per week, or seventy-five dollars \$75.00) per year."

The above minutes were read by the secretary amd approved by the Board.

On motion the meeting adjourned.
