THE NEW PURPOSE OF THE  
WOMAN'S SOCIETY OF CHRISTIAN SERVICE

Adopted January 18, 1964  
by the Woman's Div.

The purpose of the Woman's Society of Christian Service and Wesleyan Service Guild shall be to help women grow in the knowledge and experience of God as revealed in Jesus Christ and to challenge them to respond to God's redemptive purpose in the world.

Toward the realization of this purpose the Woman's Society and Guild shall provide opportunities and resources which will help women: grow in understanding and spiritual power; increase their knowledge of needs in the world; and share in the witness, service, and outreach of the church. The Woman's Society and Guild shall enlist workers and secure funds for the fulfillment of their responsibility in the mission of the church at home and overseas.

OUR GIVING

The funds of our Society are made up of money voluntarily given by the members through the circles and by the proceeds of such projects as rummage sales, dinners, and special events undertaken for the purpose of earning money.

One half of our budget is designated for benevolences. These include (1) the pledge to the Woman's Division of the Rock River Conference, (2) Conference related and Community giving, (3) Missionary and Conference giving.

#### CHRISTMAS BAZAAR AT NEWBERRY ASKS HELP

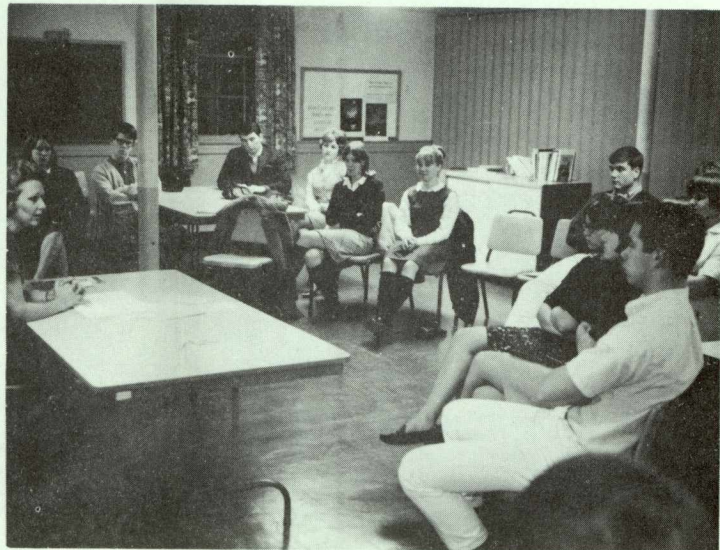
