We have had no losses in the fifty trees which were treated in Jewel Park for three years, but neither have we lost any of the fifty control trees, so the results are inconclusive. Other experiments have had good results, but the Department of Agriculture has requested additional data before registering Bidrin for use. The Nauget company and others are operating on an experimental license in Iowa, Kansas and Milwaukee this year to obtain this data. When the results of the experiments have been released, and Bidrin has been registered for use, the Forestry Committee will work with Rowland Roth and will investigate the possibilities of its use by Barrington, taking into consideration the comparable costs and effectiveness of the two methods. We hope that this information will be available in the early fall and when it is, we will act promptly and submit our recommendations to the Board. Sincerely, y Hender R. D.
