LETTER FROM PRESIDENT SCOTT ROGERS

Dear BYB&S Families:

It may not seem like it now, but summer, baseball and softball are right around the corner. And we have many exciting new developments to share, and little space to do so, so here goes. When the new Board convened in September, we took some time to focus on our purpose, and each of us committed to always keep the best interests of all the children in mind in the decisions we would make. We agreed that we would focus equally on Softball and Baseball. The House leagues would not take a back seat to Travel programs. We committed to be open, to listen and to not be afraid of change. Finally, we committed to do all this in a fiscally prudent and responsible manner.

Our softball programs will be run this year pretty much like they have been in the past few years. Hey, BHS has sent softball teams to the state semifinals three years in a row, so we must be doing something right. However, we have adopted some organizational changes make sure we give softball the attention it deserves.

On the baseball side, there are

changes for both House and Travel. For the House program, AAA and Majors will be divided into four separate leagues, one for each grade, 3-6. The Red/White format has been eliminated. It is never easy trying to determine how best to structure youth baseball programs, and balancing concepts such as learning, competitiveness, development and fun (and I stress FUN), is a uniquely difficult process. No matter what you think about the old or new structure, this year it will be far more likely that classmates will play together, and best friends need not worry about not being in the same league. And when classmates play against each other, we certainly won't have to worry about competition.

For Travel, we are expanding the full time baseball travel opportunities. We will now have two 10 year old teams, two 11 year old teams and one more 12 year old team. Details, including registration information, can be found on the website www.barringtonyouthbaseball.com, but be aware, TRAVEL TRYOUTS BEGIN ON JANUARY 16, 2007.

In the immortal words of Ron Popeil, "But wait, there's more." Look for an improved Winter Training program sponsored by BYB&S and Professional Baseball of Illinois. HOUSE PROGRAMS

In 2007, the House baseball league program is being restructured so that all players between the ages of 7 and 12 (first through sixth grades) will be playing with other players in their same grade. There will be no ■ "red/white" split as in previous years. How-■ ever, a limited number of players in grades 3 ■ ■ and 5 (maximum 2 per team) will have an ■ opportunity to "play up" in grade (subject to ■ evaluation). In addition, any player who wishes to move down an age/grade level (grades 4 and 6) to better develop his or her skills will be allowed to do so. There will be no change to the House Softball or ■ Baseball Pony or Colt leagues. The House ■ leagues run from mid-April through the end
