History of The Defense Intelligence Agency Attache Hall of Fame

The Attache Hall of Fame was established in 1988 to honor military attaches who have served with great distinction and who have made unique contributions to our nation. Biennially, all elements of the intelligence community are invited to nominate former military attaches for induction into the Hall of Fame. Nominations have come from the Secretary of State, the Director of Central Intelligence, the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff, the Service Chiefs, and the Defense Intelligence Agency.

In the inaugural ceremony held on 15 December 1988, Lieutenant General Leonard Peroots, USAF, Director of the Defense Intelligence Agency, inducted the first 37 members at a ceremony held at 3100 Clarendon Boulevard in Arlington, VA. The master of ceremonies was Major General Charles F. Scanlon, USA, Deputy Director for Attaches and Operations. The guest speaker was Lieutenant General Samuel V. Wilson, USA (Ret.), a former Director of DIA.

The second induction ceremony was held on 29 June 1990 at 3100 Clarendon Boulevard in Arlington, VA. The ceremony was hosted by Lieutenant General Harry E. Soyster, USA, and nine attaches were inducted into the Hall of Fame. The master of ceremonies was Major General Charles F. Scanlon, USA, Deputy Director for Attaches and Operations. The Guest Speaker was Ambassador Paul Wolfowitz, Deputy Under Secretary of Defense for Policy.

The previous induction ceremony was held on 9 June 1992 at the DIAC. Ten former attaches were inducted into the Hall of Fame. The ceremony was hosted by Lieutenant General James R. Clapper, Jr, USAF, Director of DIA. The Master of Ceremonies was Mr. Charles W. Rhodes, Acting Deputy Director for Attaches and Operations. The guest speaker was General William A. Knowlton, USA (Ret).

This year's ceremony is scheduled to coincide with the 30th anniversary of the Defense Intelligence Agency assuming the responsibilities for the Defense Attache System from the individual services.
