There is now nearing completion in the New York zoological park a new house for birds which bids fair to be unique among such buildings in the United States, if not Indeed in the Workl, says C, William Beebe in the New York Post. It will consist of two large exhibition hails, built in the shape of an L, one, the parrot room, measuring sixty-five foor in length, while the main hall is sevently-seven feed long by fifty feet wide, and about thirty six feet to the apex of the food. These rooms are lined ail around with spacetose ranges, nine to twelve feet in height.
