IUMP FROM BROKEN WINDOWS

One Youth Leaps to Sidewalk From Upper Gallery, a Distance of Fifty Feet, While Other Persons Smash Glass to Escape.

Kokomo, Ind., dispatch: A fire in the upper balcomy of the Sipe theater Sunday night, caused by the ignition of moving picture films, sent a streak of flame far back into the gallery, burning scores of persons, and caused a panic in which acores of others were injured.
