State of Wisconsin Is Entitled to Recover \$160,000 From the Carriers.

SOUGHT TO EVADE PAYMENT

fficials Knowingly and Wilfully Omits ted Portion of Gross Larnings From Report to Commissioner on Advice of Attorneys.

Madison, Wis, dispatch: Wisconsin is entitled to recover \$150,000 from the railroads operating in the state, according to a decision given by Judge Stevens in the elecute court. The state won its case against the Chicago and Northwestern, Chicago, Miwalikes and St. Paul, Chicago, St. Paul, Minnespolis and Omaha, and the Minnespolis, St. Paul and Saulte Ste Marie railroads.

The court finds the state is entitled to recover from each of these made \$10,000 as these lines admitted they had incorrectly filed their reports of gross samings made by the state for the year 1901. The same statute pro-vides for a separate penalty for each year that incorrect reports were filed.

Entitled to Large Sum.

The state still has an action against these roads to recover penalties upon the reports of earnings which they made for 1903. The state has penalty suits also against the Wisconia Central road, the Green Bay and Western, the Chicago, Burlington and Quincy, and Illinois Central.
