Where Case Is Heard.

Washington—It is doubtful if a more momentous decision in the Interest of American society has been delivered by the supreme court in recent years than when Monday, by a beach divided five to four, it held that divorces obtained in slates which do not have jurisdiction over both parties to a marriage are not aforceable outside the state granting them. The decision is based on the clause of the shall give rall faith and credit to the decrees of another state.

The effect of the decision therefore is that divorces like those obtained in South Dakota by the acquisition of a temporary residence for that purpose are valid in the state in which the couple resided only so long as their legality is not attacked.
