Bryan Tells an Intervi low He Stands on the Issues of 1904.

HEIS MORE RADICAL THAN EVER

London, July 13.—William J. Bryan, having had the opportunity of reading newspapers from the United States. consented to discuss some of the questions which have been raised since he has again become prominent as a presidential possibility. He said: "I notice that I am now described by some as conservative, and in order that there may be no misunderstanding on that subject permit me to say that in one sense I always have been a conservative. The Democratic policies are conservative in that they embody old principles applied to new condi-
