

Bee Culture. The illustration shows the idea. I use a piece of 5x14 steel tire for the backbone, as I call it, and a leaf of a buggy-spring for the front part. The spring has to be drawn out thin except about a foot in the center where the backbone is welded on. You can carry a hive in both hands if it is not too heavy. To put it on a hive you take hold of the front part, spread it open, and slip it forward until the back end hooks on; then the more you lift, the more it holds on. It wants to be made so that it touches the outsides and end about three lunches. Make one and try it; and if you like it, let other bee-keepers see how funch easier it is to use this than it is to carry these in the arms.
