Sheep Raising in Australia.

The greatest industry of Australia is sheep raising, mainly for the sake of the wool, but also in part, of course, for the meat. Australia now ranks second among the great sheep-raising countries, Argentina being first with \$2,000,000 sheep, Australia second with \$0,000,000. Only a few years ago Australia was first, possessing no less than 105,250,000 head of sheep. That was in 1851. Prolonged droughts were the cause of the destruction of many millions of Australia sheep, but since 1902 there has been an annual gain. Yet these sheep were not indigenous to Australia. They were first introduced in 1975, being of the Spanish meria species.
