WILLIAM SPRIGGS

William Spriggs, a resident of Barrington for forty-seven years and a familiar figure on its streets, died yesterday morning at the age of 80. He had been ill for eight weeks, steadily ill and delirious; a long existing heart trouble was the cause of his death.

This old gentleman of eighteen years was a native of New England, but he had resided in the state for many years of honest, industry and kindly disposition.

He was an Englishman, born in Wethersfield, Conn., Jan. 21, 1823, a family of four boys. His mother died when he was two years old and he was brought up by his father, a carpenter in his home town and Peterborough near there. At eighteen he became a ranger engineer in the British army for thirty years in England. He married at twenty to Miss Jenny Whymann of Peterborough and in the early days of their marriage they had three children. They lived in what is now the home of William Peters on Grove Avenue, which is the present site of the present St. Peter's Church on Hough Street.

Mr. Spriggs was a stationary engineer in Chicago in April, 1860, and there he met and married Mrs. Anna Miller, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. William Spriggs of Chicago, a grandfather to Miss Richard Weston of Chicago.

He died in his home on Monday afternoon at half past one with Rev. O. F. Matteson conducting the service. Miss Emma Ponover and Miss May Flagg were the honor was filled with friends.

CHRIS SCHUMACHER
