Washington

Senator Martin of Virginia was elected Democratic leader of the Senate, and Senator Smith of North Carolina was elected chairman of the Senate Committee on Education and Labor. Senator Shriver of Indiana was voted for by the opposition. Martin, Shriver, and Senator Taft were from New York, voted for Shriver.

The circumstantial story published to the effect that the American troops were sent to China to fight the Boxer line because of the American invasion of Manchuria was denied by Ambassador Wilson of an alleged order of the Chinese government. It is denied most emphatically by members of congress who are in close touch with the Chinese situation.
