Washington

Postmaster General Hitchcock has designated a additional deputaries, making a total of 10 that have been appointed. The office will be ready to receive deposits, August 1.

Secretary of War Jacob M. Dickinson has been appointed to the Democratic members of Postmaster General's cabinet, has resigned. Henry L. Stimson, of the Republican party, has been appointed as successor for governor of that state. In the letter of his appointment, the president exchanged between the president and Mr. Dickinson, it was stated that the reason for presenting private affairs, is given for the secretary's retirement.

Domestic

At least a score of policemen were injured and many members of a mob of 2,000 striking furniture workers and apprentices were beaten to death at the plant of the Widdowson Furniture Company at Rahway, N. J. Several of the injured were dead. City officials dispersed the mob with firearms.
