




CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE TANK FOR STORING MANURE

The largest diameter should be in the same direction as that with the most convenient road for the teams to travel. The retaining walls should be protected from the shocks by slaking a conveniently placed slope in the front at points of probable contact. As economy is insisted on, diagonal bracing is shown. The concrete preparation of the tank will be improved by reinforced concrete of an invariable cost for making the form or the base walls high drainage for water. This may be provided by a concrete or a masonry cover but best made of concrete with a sloped grade and covered with slatted plank. 

CONSTRUCTION OF CONCRETE TANK FOR STORING MANURE

Detailed Instructions Given for Making Suitable Receipts on Farm Where Six Horses are Kept—Most Satisfactory Method in City Tank and Section Form Show.




