Arranging Circles.

Use a pair of dividers to make small circles, or, if these are not at hand, use a string and pencil attached to the ends of the string to mark the circles, and over the entire outside with lathes nailed close together, as shown in the illustration.

The circles have been entirely covered by lathes and firmly fastened to each other, so that nothing will come off and smooth all of the edges of the trunk.



EXCELLENT VENTILATION OF STABLES OF ORDINARY SIZE

Most Satisfactory System is Described and Illustrated—No Plan That Will Automatically Meet All Conditions of Wind and Weather.

Illustration Shows How Air Is Drawn Through Metal Frame.



Plans of Stable Showing Method of Ventilation.—*A. Metal frame section of stable; B. entrance; C. window; D. exhaust flue; E. back view; F. exhaust flue and side connection; G. latches; H. stable door; I. location of passage.*

For stables of ordinary size, the most satisfactory system of ventilation is that of fresh air inlet at the top, exhaust at the bottom, and a metal frame with a hinged door at the entrance.

This plan prevents direct draughts from the entrance, and the air entering is drawn through the stable.
