MAIL COLLECTION AND DELIVERY IN TOWNS.

Representative of Pennsylvania has introduced in the House of Representatives a bill providing for the experimental establishment of a mail delivery and collection service in towns of 1,000 population and over.

Business men and their organizations all over the country are interesting themselves in the project.

No letter carrier is employed in this town and the post office profits are spent elsewhere, while the business men suffer inconveniences and financial loss by being compelled to collect and deliver their own mail. The postmasters at all presidential post offices should have competent carriers assigned to them.

In the large cities free delivery is established, but the mail delivery has been given the country residents, but town people suffer just discrimination. Every postmaster town should at once petition Congress for mail carrier service.

Last year there was a surplus in the postal funds and the government is now ready to create a new and more economical mail delivery system so soon as the people in the towns will evidence their desire for modern facilities such as are enjoyed by the city and rural residents.

The report just issued by the postal department on a new mail delivery system is now in operation in 1,561 cities, serving more than 40,000,000 people. On the 45,000 rural routes 20,000,000 people receive their mail from rural carriers. This leaves a considerable percentage of our people, the majority or whom reside in towns and villages, without any form of free delivery. The reason for this is that the law leaves these in so far as by which the department can relieve this inequality. It is believed, therefore, that an experimental service should be authorized.

Proportionate to the cost of the establishment of a town mail delivery system must be taken to secure enactment of such legislation during the present session of congress. Requests for legislation should be addressed to Dr. John F. Mentzer, secretary, Ephrata, Pennsylvania, who will welcome inquiries and suggestions.

FAVORITE BREED FOR EGGS

Laghorn, Native Orpington, Are Excellent Poultry for Eggs Are the Best Layers.

If eggs are easier and cheaper to produce than meat and bring a better price, why not the egg laying breeds have a place to offer a writer in the Poetry Journal.

HANDY FOR POULTRY RAISERS

Little Device for Carrying Eggs May Be Made out of Ordinary Lath Mailed Together.

Here is a device for carrying eggs when they are delivered to you in the city, writes A. J. Maguire in the "Poultryman." It is a simple ordinary plastering lath, planed smooth and nailed together with small nails. Two small notches are cut in the lath for each corner. The bottom is made of this lath nailed to narrow strips of wood, and the top is made of a single piece of wood as a handle. The carrier can be made to hold any number of eggs, and the carrier can be mailed in a number of cartons one dozen to a carrier.

Winter Feed for Poultry.
