POSTAL SAVINGS BANK RULES.

will bear interest at the regular rate. A depositor may at any time withdraw the whole or any part of his deposits in his credit with any interest payable by surrendering savings certificate, properly indorsed, for the amount desired.

A depositor presenting a certificate for payment to full with all interest payable must indorse it on the back in the presence of the postmaster or his representative and surrender it. The postmaster or his representative, if satisfied as to the depositor's identity, will then make payment.

When a depositor desires to withdraw only a part of the amount called for by any certificate, the postmaster will cancel the certificate and issue a new certificate covering the amount to be left on deposit. The new certificate will be dated that the depositor will not lose interest on the amount remaining continuously on deposit.

When a depositor desires to withdraw merely the interest payable on any certificate, instead of indorsing and surrendering the certificate as in case of full payment, he will be required to give his request in duplicate for the amount of the interest paid. The postmaster will enter the interest payment on the back of the certificate and return it to the depositor.

In case of the death of a depositor, the estate or administrator of his estate upon compliance with the necessary requirements.

A woman who opens an account and afterwards marries must present her savings certificate at her office in order that the certificate may be indorsed as payable to her in life.

A depositor will be permitted to exchange the whole or any part of his savings certificate for \$100, \$50, \$20, \$10 or multiples of \$100 up to and including \$100 in United States registered or coupon bonds bearing interest at the rate of 7 1/2 per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually, redeemable at the pleasure of the United States at any time from date of issue, both principal and interest, repayable 20 years from date in United States gold coin. Such exchange may be made under date of January 1 and the following year, provided such bonds are then available.

Sealed proposals will be received by the Board of Local Improvements of the Village of Lake Zurich, in the County of Lake, and State of Illinois, until 1 o'clock, P. M., on the 25th day of February, A. D. 1912 at the Village Hall, 211 South First Street, Lake Zurich, Illinois, to wit: the construction of a complete system of cast iron water supply pipes, with two hydraulic gate valves, valve boxes and appurtenances. Said system to be located and installed as follows: Beginning at a point in Robertson Avenue opposite the south line of lot 3, in Block 1, of E. S. Brown's subdivision, the six inch cast iron water main 270 feet long shall be laid in Robertson Avenue and Main Street, thence a line which is parallel to and twenty feet from the south line of Robertson Avenue, ending at a point in Main street, which is 100 feet west of the west line of the subject lot in Park Park. Also in Lake View Road a four inch cast iron water pipe 335 feet long, which shall connect with the six inch water pipe at Robertson Avenue, shall be laid along a line which is parallel to and twenty feet from the east line of said street, commencing at a point where this line produced intersects the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue, and ending at a point opposite the south line of lot 12, in block one, of the East Shore Subdivision. Also in Lake Street a six inch cast iron water pipe 270 feet long, which shall connect with the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue, shall be laid along a line which is parallel to and twenty feet from the south line of said street, commencing at a point where this line produced intersects the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue, and ending at a point opposite the east line of lot 12, in block one, of E. S. Brown's subdivision. Also in Park Avenue, a four inch cast iron water pipe 800 feet long, which shall connect with the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue, shall be laid along a line which is parallel to and twenty feet from the east line of said street, commencing at a point where this line produced intersects the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue, and ending at a point opposite the east line of lot 12, in block one, of Prospect Park Addition, and the right-of-way line of the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railroad. Also in Palace Street and McHenry Road, a six inch water pipe 200 feet long, which shall connect with the six inch water pipe in Robertson Avenue and Main Street, shall be laid along a line which is parallel to and twenty feet from the eastern line of said streets, commencing at a point in McHenry Road opposite the east line of 4th street, and ending at a point in Palace Street where this line intersects the Western High-Way line of the Elgin, Joliet and Eastern Railroad. All in the Village of Lake Zurich, in the County of Lake and State of Illinois, according to the ordinance thereto and the plans and specifications for said improvement on file in the office of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of said Village and Village Hall, and at the office of the Engineer of said Village of Lake Zurich.

Proposals must be addressed to the President of the Board of Local Improvements of the Village of Lake Zurich, at Lake Zurich, Illinois, and include "Proposal For Water Main" and be accompanied with a certified check for an amount equal to ten per cent of the aggregate proposed, to be held as security for the completion of the work, and to be returned to the order of the President of the Board of Local Improvements of said Village, with or without interest, as the case may be, on the 25th day of February, A. D. 1912, at said Village Hall, 211 South First Street, Lake Zurich, Illinois. The contractor who is awarded the contract to draw interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum, pursuant to the statute in such case made and passed March 1, 1907, shall be deemed to have accepted the right to reject any and all bids.

No bids will be received unless the contractor offering it shall furnish evidence satisfactory to the Board of Local Improvements of his ability, and that he has the necessary facilities, together with sufficient pecuniary resources, to fulfill the conditions of the contract and specifications, provided such contract should be awarded him.

Companys or firms bidding must give the individual names with their respective addresses, as well as the name of the firm or company.

The work proposed to be done is to be completed within a period of 60 days from the date of the award of the contract. The contractor shall be held responsible for the faithful performance of his contract and for the maintenance of said work in good condition for a period of five years.
