Farmers Buy Stock

Increased interest in the new factory policy for farmers, which is designed to meet the future welfare of Barrington and the required \$10,000 worth of shares have been sold. Administration of the machine, which has been thoroughly explained in the columns of this paper, was natural to the farmers who have been present at the meetings held at the E. J. E. E. rail-road tracks on Main street.

A complete exhibition of the parts of the machine, a practical combination corn blower and job filter were given, which proved to those present that the model was all that was claimed for it and more. It is intended to be sold. As a result of the successful meeting at Saturday several shares were sold and it was practically closed the deal for this new factory.

On Saturday of this week a meeting of those who are the head of business in the community, and a general review of the business, past and present, will be presented to the high party who will hold the presidentship. The members of the board of directors of the company will gather, some time next week to make preparations to securing the site of the factory building, and the date will be fixed.

If certain plans materialized the new building will be erected on Waukegan Avenue, between the E. J. E. E. and the Illinois Central, which will provide a very safe place to do business, shipping facilities accessible to both the Chicago and Northwestern railroads.

Have You Got 1913 Licensed? Barrington automobile owners who have not secured their 1913 license tags should look out or they will find themselves in trouble.

Reports have been circulated that the state, through the aid of local representatives, intends to start a new investigation into the cars not displaying the 1913 license tag.

The state law, it is pointed out, provides that the license tags begin to be issued in November, and the cars not displaying new license tags on November 1. Considerably over a month has passed and many people still exhibit the old tags.

While a large number of local people have secured the new tags it appears that a majority will not have them by the time the cars are on the roads. They have not been able to secure a new license as a result of a shortage of tags at the time.

The state legislature has a right to cause the arrest of people who fail to take out their license, and have waited long enough to get them, and are not going to do so. Now they intend to round up all those who have neglected their duty, and procedure may follow. The state law, it is to be noted, may be altered so that tags cannot be secured will not suffice.
