## DEATH CLAIMS AGED RESIDENT ON FRIDAY

**Henry Plage Succumbs Following an Attack of Pneumonia**

—Funeral Monday

Death came as a relief to Henry Plage, one of Barrington's well known residents. Friday of last week, following an attack of pneumonia, he had been in bed with a general break down in health; taken from our midst, son of the late George Plage, father, George Plage, and three sons to mourn his departure.

For the past four years, Mr. Plage had been a quiet, low keyed citizen, and in recent years had seen his health fail, and had failed him, making his comfort and joys as at home less appreciated. He had been a man of the world, patient and never complainful to the members of his family. Since the death of his wife, his only daughter, Miss Minnie Plage, had been his constant helper and joy to her father in his declining years.

Mr. Plage was born November 2, 1868, in Wittenberg, Hanover, Germany. He emigrated to this country in 1882, settling at North Northfield, in which community he farmed and rode to Miss Wittenberg Turner on May 9, 1902, and after a period of ten years spent at North Northfield and Lake Zurich, he moved to the farm now occupied by George Lappert, one and one-half miles to the south of here. He remained for two years, moving to the Wittenberg community, then to Lake Zurich, and three years later he had exchanged the Rieger farm three miles south of here, which he continued to farm for forty years. For the past two years he had made his home in Barrington.

Mr. Plage was the father of eight children, five sons, four daughters, who preceded the death in his wife.

Mr. Plage having passed away two days ago, was buried Saturday in the cemetery located just west of his residence, and was followed by a funeral service.

He was a man of a faithful, active and honored member of the church.

The funeral services, Monday, were in charge of the pastor of the Zion church, of which he was a member, and were conducted in the home prior to the close at the church.

Rev. J. Elfrink, a life-long friend and acquaintance, delivered the sermon.

After the service Rev. H. D. Hester spoke in English. Rev. H. D. Hester also took part in the services. Suitable services were rendered by Misses Maudie Wiesen, Clara Wiesen, Lillian Augusta, and Mrs. J. C. Caldwell.



### PREPARATORY WORK FOR FALL AND WINTER

What about the winter window garden?

Now is the time for much work that cannot be delayed.

(Of the best winter blooming geraniums is the Mrs. E. H. Hill.

Many flowers should be discarded and new ones started.

Do not let the geraniums get leggy, thin them out.

Pinch out all buds from plants intended for the window garden.

Let the plants grow.

Flowers and plants are not satisfied.

Begin now.

Get your soil, manures and potting soil together.

Clean, scour and put in place the pots for winter. Have every vessel.

Use drainage in your drainage, old root trim wood ashes are as good as gold.

Replant all plants needing it, cut back severely. Don't try to keep everything.

Try to have your plants at their best when it is time to take them in.

Pinch and prune into good shape.

Drops of water must not stand on leaves of the globe, as water will rot it.

Get seedlings from the florist, from your garden and thirty for winter blooming.

# PEACE IS URGED BY THE POPE; NO REPARATION

Suggests Foundation for Negotiations Along Lines Indorsed by Wilson.

## OFFER INSPIRED BY BERLIN

Atkins Reduction in Armaments and Submission of Disputes to Arbitration as Basis for Negotiations—Favored Preservation of Belgian and Peaceful Solution of the Problem of Alsace-Lorraine, Trept, and Ruhr Problem.

Bonne, Italy, Aug. 16.—Pope Benedict's peace proposals have been delivered to all the belligerent governments. The pope suggests that the Berlin, Berlin, Berlin, Brussels, and peaceful solution of the problem of Alsace-Lorraine, Trept, and Ruhr.

**Indorse Plan of President.** President Wilson's plan of reduction of future wars by some form of international organization, which has held the necessary power to enforce its judgments is given by Pope Benedict, who states that such a systematic project must go an effective arrangement for reduction of armaments to a point sufficient for defense of the world, to carry out the mandates of the world's freedom.
