GIVING THE POTATO CROP A QUICK START

One of the most discouraging dates for the potato grower is the long frost which comes right after the potatoes are planted.

Some weeks are ready to start right off the bat. In their potato fields have saved up plant food for just this emergency. The potato, however, is not a good forager, and too often a delay in getting a quick start means a partial or total crop failure. The most important plant food in the early spring is ammonia—the nitric and leaf producer. At the time of year when potatoes are planted, the soil is still cold. It has just been leached by the winter's rains and is low in available plant food. When nitric fertilizer is applied to a cold and turned under, it will be absorbed in fertilizer—from 2 to 3 per cent—of its most profitable practice.
