Washington

The intention of Japan to retain exclusive control of Yap and to deny the United States not only cable rights but the commercial open door in this and other former German islands in the north Pacific is disclosed in a dispatch from Washington.

The resolution authorizing an investigation of the scope of Great Cleveland, Philadelphia, draft order, who is now in Germany, was adopted by the house at Washington without opposition.

The United States Supreme court at Washington upheld the power of congress and the state legislatures to enact anti-proliferating laws to protect states from foreign epidemics.

Secretary Hughes, in a letter to Samuel Dossman at Washington, says that the United States will never recognize economic violators with Russia while the present social regime remains.

Congress will refuse to enact laws which would allow Japan to annex the United States, Japan, under the leadership of the house, declared at Washington. He also reiterated his belief that there should be no "aiding" of tax burdens.

Frank White of Valley City, N. D., was nominated by President Harding for the United States, Mr. White is a former governor of North Dakota and was elected in the American army in France.

President Harding at Washington commended the early recognition of American representation on the reparations commission and in other European commissions, and in other European countries involving American rights and interests.

The house of Washington, by a vote of 220 to 112, passed the emergency tariff bill. This bill was introduced by Mr. Dismore and passed by the house.

With the season calling off in London of the triple alliance strike order affecting the rail and transport workers and agricultural system of "wrecking" the part of the miners, Great Britain is in a state of emergency.
