Coal Production of State Drops, 2 1/2 Million Off

Springfield—Production of coal in Illinois shrank more than two and one-half million tons during the month of January as compared with the same month in 1922, according to the monthly report of the Department of Mines and Minerals. For January a productive of 6,006,281 tons was reported, as compared to 8,255,147 tons for December.

The output for the year, month to month, decreased by 2,153,147 tons as compared to the productive of January, 1922, when 8,253,128 tons were produced.

182 Miles in Operation

Report for January shows 152 miles in operation in the state, while 128 miles were in operation in December. Of the 152 miles, 20,012 miners were employed an average of 1.81 days per month.

150 Accidents for the Month

Practically all fatalities were reported in Vermilion, Co., during the month of January. Deaths of Mr. and Mrs. William and Woodford, the same period, were the only fatalities from employment. Of the deaths, 150 were attributed to accidents, while

Eighteen Fatal Accidents

Practically all fatalities during the month of January, 19,611 miners, working 15.93 days during the month, produced the largest amount of coal ever produced in the state, 1,545,000 tons.

150 New Lawmen


