## DEBASING CRUELTY

In many periods there appears to be a well defined inclination to cruelty, especially towards animals, upon which they inflict needless suffering without the slightest pity. In fact, many seem to take a twisted delight in the agonies of unfortunate creatures.

To one of normal sensibilities, it is hard to explain this sort of depravity, which is often found among children, as well as among older persons. It must be a manifestation of some kind of mental abnormality, and of a cruel nature. Cruelty to animals indicates a certain baseness, which usually inclines cruel propensities towards human beings.

Not always, however, is it deliberate, meditated cruelty. But none the less, it is a cruel thing. Forcing a dog to ride on the running board of an automobile is a case in point. A sudden swerve, or a quick turn around a corner, and the poor animal, if thrown, will crack the wheels of his own, or, if falling car, he scrambles to his feet and dashes madly after the vehicle. He is soon hopelessly outdistanced and he is left to be hunted down and shot like a wild creature as he searches frantically for the human whom he called master.

Another instance was seen in the movie news reels recently—a police dog baying a man's record in an endurance award on the Hudson river. The man who met the record and the other man who was to beat it, were both given the same form of marathons to the point of exhaustion, have a prize, or the desire to hang up a record, to spur them on. The poor dog, however, was not given the same incentive. He was to be beaten, to be humiliated, to be degraded, to be degraded and humiliated; he could have turned and made the shore in a few minutes. His faithfulness forced him to follow the man who led the way in a boat. Had there been a purpose in forcing the poor brute to the limit of his endurance, as in the case of the hunkies that carried medicines to a stricken community, or in the case of the men, we could applaud the dog, and the man who trained him. In the present instance this hardly fits the animal for falling into such hands.

The time to correct tendencies to thoughtless cruelty as well as deliberate cruelty, is now. Children should be taught to avoid practices which tend to make callous to the agonies of helpless creatures. It should be explained to them that when it is necessary to kill animals for food or for the safety of human life, it should be done as swiftly and humanely as possible; never with the intention of inflicting pain.

Teachers in schools and Sunday schools might do a great deal more than is being done now in the way of humane education, while parents and communities should endeavor to correct tendencies toward cruelty on the part of their children.

## WOMEN'S POLITICAL POWER

Canada has long looked to the progress and success of its farming and cooperative marketing enterprises, which have materialized at the solution of at least a portion of the agricultural problem.

The co-operative movement has attracted the strong support of farm women in many parts of the Dominion, an outstanding example of their activities being the Saskatchewan egg and poultry pool, with a membership of 15,000, composed almost entirely of women, with four women on its board of directors.

Last year this association handled 70 per cent of the eggs marketed in the province and 88 per cent of the poultry products. The volume of business amounting to \$721,329. This showing is all the more remarkable from the fact that the larger portion of the eggs do not come from the poultry farms, but from those in which poultry raising is only a side line to the grain production. The co-operative marketing of agricultural products has not only increased the active support of farm women but has also been a great help to the farmer. The Saskatchewan poultry pool is a splendid example of what can be accomplished through their aptitude for intelligent co-operative effort.

## HOW FIRES START

If your home or business building burns down it will generally be due to one of the following causes, according to the National Fire-Prevention Council, which names these:

1. Improper building construction.
2. Defective wiring or other improper installation of equipment furnishing heat, power and lights.
3. Careless storage or handling of explosive or combustible liquids.
4. Handling and use of nitro-cellulose films.
5. Accumulations of trash and rubbish.
6. Carelessness with matches and in disposing of cigar and cigarette butts.

With the exception of the first named, all of these causes are preventable and largely eliminated with little or no expense.

This is Fire Prevention Week—a good time to check up. Summed up, the fact is that at least two-thirds of the fires which destroy more than \$500,000,000 worth of property and about 15,000 human lives each year may be traced directly to pure carelessness.

It is a terrible price to pay for stupidity and reckless disregard of danger.

## ENCOURAGING CRIME

Carelessness and stupidity on the part of the victims is responsible for much of the thieving and swindling which has reached such alarming proportions in this country, amounting to approximately two billions a year.

Some of the specific weaknesses of our "easy marks" are pointed out by a leading criminologist, who enumerates cashing checks for strangers, leaving automobiles unprotected, carrying unnecessarily large sums of money, buying real estate without seeing or investigating the title, investing in stocks and schemes without consulting a banker, trying to beat gamblers at the card games, lending money and extending credit to persons of doubtful honesty, and so on.

If people fail to exercise any caution whatever in these matters, no law or official action can effectively protect them from thieves, swindlers and duffers.

While the punishment of criminals often assists, it usually happens too late to do the victim any good, so far as recovering his money or possessions is concerned.

Honest people have it in their own power to greatly reduce losses from the above mentioned causes, by merely exercising a little good judgment, instead of indulging in reckless practices which encourage crime.

## GETTING INTO A RUT

Owing to the growing tendency toward specialization in every department of human activity, it is becoming more difficult for the average man to keep in touch with what is going on outside his own immediate interests. He becomes so engrossed with his own affairs that he runs a great risk of getting into a rut.

While the extensions of modern business and professional life lead necessarily to a high degree of specialization, the average man is not permitted to unduly restrict his mental horizon. Everyone should take sufficient time to keep abreast with important developments in the world around him. By doing so he will often encounter ideas which will be of practical benefit in his own sphere of activity.

Above all, he should lay aside routine duties frequently for the purpose of indulging in systematic thinking. Many men are so busy that they get so far away from the scene of their daily labors.

Whatever may be the details of any method adopted to put the mind into a rut, it should be devoted to sound reading covering varied subjects. Otherwise he will inevitably get into a rut. And getting into a rut is bad for his intellect and bad for his business.

## BLINDFOLDED SMOKERS

Can you pick your favorite cigarette by its taste and smell if blindfold while smoking? The answer is no. The question has been raised recently through a series of advertisements that can be read by users of a certain brand.

According to Louis Goodman of Reed College in Oregon, who made exhaustive tests covering two months with 20 confirmed smokers. These smokers distinguished their favorite brands only one out of eight times when blindfolded. Pure guessing would have

given correct answers oftener than that. He also found that the smokers could seldom tell the difference between cigarettes made of domestic tobacco and those containing straight Turkish after smoking 100 cigarettes of each brand. One smoker offered to bet that neither of the three were of that brand and so on.

As a result of his experiments Mr. Goodman concluded that the preference of a smoker for this or that brand is due to imagination probably stimulated by advertising. Try the blindfold test on yourself if you don't believe him.
