School to Offer Christmas Seals Beginning Monday

The sale of International Christmas seals will be handled locally by the Barrington public school system, offering the seals at steady hours and in steady places.

In 1927 millions of Christmas seals were sold in the United States, and prevent tuberculosis, but in many countries the originator of the seal gave a portion of the money for a cure to a group of tuberculosis children in that state.

At that time a children's hospital was founded in Barrington, and Einar Hilleboth, a postman in that town, was the first to sell the seals, designed to decrease consumption and perhaps help in the cure of the disease.

That was the beginning of the Christmas seal, and the seal was designed and named David Rose, a pioneer in social service.

After a year a letter was received about the project. Impressed by the results, the postmaster of that town, published in the "Outlook" that the seals had achieved in Denmark. In that article, the author, Ole Hansen, of Odense, Denmark, told of the seals.
