## THE STOREKEEPERS'

Those of us who are past middle age can remember when the kindly neighbor whose job it was to sell us the necessities of life was known as a storekeeper. The name was quite appropriate. He bought a stock of goods, hung out his sign, sometimes, and waited for his neighbors and friends to drop in and buy.

Later on, his son inherited the business, if it had gone to the wall, adopted a slightly more aggressive attitude toward the securing of trade, and called himself a merchant. Here and there a venturesome soul began to really study business methods and actually plan for greater volume and a wider trade and radius. Some became real business men and reaped rich rewards.

Later still, the department store and mail order house came into existence, recently followed by the chain stores, which now seem to menace the small merchant, and even threaten to drive him out of business.

In spite of these revolutionary developments, however, thousands of independent merchants are making money today. They are doing it through adopting scientific methods of buying and selling, through co-operation in buying, through the employment of systematic accounting, through a study of their customers' requirements, and through advertising.

But a great many seem such neophytes in business that in the race they have fallen far behind. They don't know why, but to anyone with a fundamental knowledge of modern business practices the reason is plain. These failures are not business men; nor even merchants—they are only storekeepers.

## THE PLANTS SCATTER

In a recent article, Basil Manly, a well-known economist, called attention to the location of a large automobile tire factory at Gadsden, Ala., which he declared to be the beginning of a movement to decentralize the tire industry from the large tire manufacturing centers in the United States. This in line with the general industrial trend which is in the direction of decentralization of manufacturing, instead of concentration in congested areas.

Mr. Manly quoted leading tire manufacturers and southern leaders who predict a general movement of tire factories to the southern states, where they will be scattered over a wide territory, many of them in towns of comparatively small size, such as Gadsden.

The same reasons that have caused other industries to move and some communities are given as contributing factors. Thus, the movement by the tire factories, mainly, means to raw materials, a more satisfactory class of labor, better living conditions for workers, abundant and cheap electric power, and a highly marked for the manufactured product.

That this shift of manufacturing to the smaller cities and towns will enable many of them to rapidly grow in importance and prosperity can not be denied. Eventually, however, it will be necessary to secure its share of new industries, which make payrolls, better markets for products of the farm, and thereby confer benefits upon town and rural populations alike.

## DEATH OF TIC RICKARD

Public interest in sports being what it is, the death of George L. "Tic" Rickard in Miami, Fla., a brief illness attracted nationwide notice beyond that which might attach to the passing of a high official or other dignitary.

Rickard was a character such as is commonly described as "colorful," and his personal life, a picture of chivalry and romance, served to keep him in the limelight for several years. And it can not be denied that in his peculiar line of office he was a master.

Any person who can induce a crowd of fighters to pay \$2,650,000 to witness a boxing bout, as he did to see Tunney win a decision over Dempsey on September 22,

1927, is a shovman extraordinary. In several other battles staged by Rickard the gate receipts were between \$1,000,000 and \$1,800,000.

While the followers of *lafcadio* felt that Rickard was a shovman, the critics did not share this opinion and he might have given up his former exploits had he lived. With his passing it may be that exponents of the many art will be placed on a financial basis more in keeping with their real importance in the world.

## 5 OFF TO A FLYING START

Aviation, in the year 1929 is literally "off to a flying start." The first few days of the new year saw the epoch-making sustained flight of the big Argentinean, the Question, from Europe to America, a distance of 10,000 miles, being realized more than a year in mid-air, both day and night.

Another important development since January 1 is the inauguration of the air mail between the United States and Central America and to islands of the Caribbean.

Woman's part in aviation has also emphasized itself in the record-making transoceanic flight for women by Miss Bobbie Trout, who remained in the air more than 12 hours; also by Miss Amelia Earhart's flight with the Central American air mail.

Soon we may hear of new exploits by Bird in the Inter. No end of ambitions and high ideals are being planned throughout the world. It looks as though 1929 is going to be another great flying year.

## WOULD RA HOover

Herbert Hoover will not take his seat as President of the United States if Gustave F. Eshling of Cleveland has his way. Eshling had filed a suit with a view to the removal of the seal from the office on the ground that he had not resided in the United States for the required length of time before his election.

It appears that Mr. Eshling has some other ideas not shared by people generally; for example, he has written extensively in an effort to prove that the world is flat. The public is equally lured by all of services of this church.

## ANOTHER DOG HERO

From Germany comes a well-authenticated press story concerning the rescue of two boys from the icy waters of the Danube by a dog who had been trained to swim and retrieve.

While shaking, the children broke off the ice and cried for help. A hunter who happened to be near by commanded his dog to go after them. After five plunges the animal caught one of the children and drew him to the shore. Immediately the dog went for the second, who had shifted under the ice. After a direct struggle, he was, too, brought out by the dog, which then collapsed.

Resuscitation was employed to "finish" life-saving procedure, and two more human beings were indebted to a dog for saving them from death.

## FEWER LYNCHINGS

Records compiled by the Tuskegee Institute show 16 lynchings in the United States during the year 1928, compared with 15 in 1927, 30 for 1926, 17 for 1925, 16 for 1924, 33 for 1923 and 57 for 1922.

While the figure for 1928 was the same as for 1927, the number of Negroes lynched was kept at a minimum. In one of the cases at least, it was afterwards proved that the man lynched was innocent of the crime for which he was killed.

Of the 16 lynched in 1928, all but one were Negroes. The Negroes lynched were 2,200, 2, killing officers of the 3rd, 4. Louisiana, 2, Texas 2, Missouri 1, New Mexico 1.

Score another for Ben Franklin, printer first to harness electricity. He also claims the honor of being the first to introduce the broomcorn to America. Franklin planted his stalks in India, a small broom, which had seeds on its stalks. Franklin planted the seeds, raised broomcorn and encouraged his friends to start the industry in New England. Franklin's efforts were rewarded, and cities of cotton and broomcorn and vacuum cleaners, the United States used more than fifty million brooms last year.
