



MOTHER'S DAY

Mother's Day, which is the second Sunday in May, falls on May 12 this year, and will be observed throughout the United States in response to the annual proclamation by the President.

As is well known, the object of the day is to recall memories of the mothers, who have passed to the beyond and to pass peaceful tributes of affection to those living. The badge for the day is the white carnation, emblematic of the purity, beauty and fidelity of a mother's love. By some the red carnation is worn in honor of living mothers.

As is well known, the original

idea of Mother's Day, which was observed in several cities in 1910, the custom being extended rapidly in the following years.

Congress in 1913 passed a resolution, offered by Congressman J. Thor Heflin of Alabama (now senator) recommending observance of the day by its members and by the states. The resolution was adopted. In 1914 Congress authorized the President to designate the second Sunday in May of each year as Mother's Day, the first proclamation under this authority being issued by President Wilson on May 9, 1914.

Few of us reflect as often, as we should, on the debt of love and gratitude we owe to our mothers. The thoughts and acts of simple affection on Mother's Day, we only honor them, but also honor ourselves.

RADIO TRAPS BANDITS

The practical uses of radio have been demonstrated in many ways, but what may prove to be one of its greatest benefits to society is being developed through its use in criminal detection.

Perhaps the most up-to-date arrangement of this kind is now in operation in Chicago, where the Tribune has installed special receiving sets for various police squads of the city, all tuned to the wave-length of that newspaper's radio station, WGN.

When notice of a crime is telephoned to WGN, the regular program is interrupted and a short message is broadcast giving the location of the crime, description of the criminal, if known, and any other information which might lead to the capture of the culprit.

One night recently two robbers escaping in an automobile were captured within five minutes after the radio alarm was broadcast. Numerous other similar captures have followed.

Criminals usually turn all new inventions to their best, but it is difficult to see how they are going to beat the radio system if it comes into general use. Of course, this plan can only be successfully employed in the case of certain classes of crimes, but the knowledge that it is, in use, will eventually tend to upset the morale of the criminal class.

GOLD STAR MOTHERS

Next year the first of the pilgrimages of Gold Star mothers will be to the cemeteries of the United States government, which will be made, and already applications are pouring into the War Department from those entitled to the privilege of visiting the graves of their sons in "Flanders field."

Widows of American soldiers buried in France, as well as mothers, will be eligible for these trips, which will be arranged by the War Department, provided and paid for. Gold Star mothers will be paid for their services, but they will not be remunerated. It is estimated that about 30,000 women all told will be entitled to this privilege if they desire to avail themselves of it.

There will be three pilgrimages, in 1930, 1931 and 1932, and generally speaking those applying for the trip will be permitted to go first. Provision will be made to take approximately 10,000 each year.

In passing this law, Congress did a most graceful and patriotic act, and it is hoped that every mother or widow who has a loved one buried "over there" may take advantage of the government's generosity in arranging the pilgrimages.

IN THE PUBLIC EYE

It is well known, even to the layman, that the value of a news story depends upon the personality of the individual concerned and the public interest in that person. Karl A. Goss, a member of the United Press, recently undertook to select "the most interesting news personalities in the world" at the present time. These are his selections:

TO MAKE MORE JOBS

As a result of the present government commissions were not enough, Senator Couzens of Michigan proposed that Congress shall create another, a Communications Commission, with five high-salaried commissioners appointed by the President, to "regulate" all forms of wire, cable and radio messages, both domestic and with foreign countries.

The fact that such enterprises are already regulating themselves by executive orders, and by state and national laws, does not appeal to members of Congress who have given the commission the mania. More government jobs are demanded, and the easiest way to supply them is to set up additional boards and commissions to inflict themselves on the long suffering taxpayers.

General Harlan recently pointed out, regulating commissions are already costing the people of the United States more than \$500,000,000 a year.

These are directed toward hampering and harassing business and industry, through the operation of an army of government spies, inspectors and what not.

But we suppose Senator Couzens will get his Communications Commission. A suggestion for creating new government jobs seldom fails to win Congressional approval.

PRINCE'S PLAY DAYS END

Although King George may have several years of life yet before him, as everyone hopes, there is grave doubt that he will even again be able to fulfil his duties as British monarch.

It is believed that the Prince of Wales will shortly be made Regent and assume the kingship.

Already he has performed some of the royal functions as a member of the Cabinet Council of Regency, and he has recently taken several significant steps in preparation for the responsibilities which will be his. He has assumed, in his role of Prince of Wales, the rôle of a general, and one of his first five horses, which indicates that his days of care-free play are at an end.

Perhaps no ruler ever came to the throne of England with so firm a hold off the affection of his people as the Prince of Wales enjoys, or with more sincere admirers throughout the world. His wife travels with countless friends for himself and for the British Commonwealth, which will stand him in good stead in the years to come.
