MOTOR CLUB GIVES GOOD ADVICE ON POISON IVY PLANT

CHICAGO, Ill.—"Leaves three; let them be," is good advice for avoiding that misery caused by poison ivy. The plant, which grows in clusters of flowers or white berries in conjunction with the three leaves, says a bulletin issued by the touring bureau of the Chicago Motor Club.

While this rule may lead to the avoidance of an effective measure of safety, it is indicated by botanists that a simple and effective measure of safety is to be taken by the agriculturist, the bulletin said.

"Poison ivy grows very high as well as low growing," the bulletin continues. "It is best to walk against the plants, or from them, to avoid touching them, which can cause a severe irritation."

It is recommended that a person should be washed and rinsed several times, particularly in cold water, to remove any possible particular irritation. Kitchen or laundry soaps containing oil of camphor are recommended.

A physician should be called.

If it is available, aspen, sassafras, or common soap root, a poultice of potassium permanganate solution, locally known as "blue-eyes," or a poultice of cooking soda or Epsom salts, one or two trayspoonfuls of each, will be found helpful.

These solutions may be applied with a handkerchief, a piece of cloth, or a sponge, and cleaned frequently in order to remove any remaining poison. The skin should be carefully cleaned and dried at night and left exposed to the air. If the skin is severely irritated, several minutes in water as hot as possible will be found helpful, but not the moment, but relief follows.

"Poisonous substances remain in the skin for a long time, perhaps a year, and may appear again, or it may not appear for five years, so it is important to wash it now and then, and finally to pointed to the hole in the bottom and asked: 'Is it the water out? I said.'
