GOVERNMENT METHODS

President Hoover is said to be strongly in favor of readjusting the functions of the various governmental departments and his recent statement that the activities may be grouped together instead of being scattered all over the national capital.

The best illustration of the present chaotic condition of affairs was given by Mr. Hoover himself some time ago, when he said:

"The question of governmental aids to navigation is not by any means one of the principal functions of our government, but it is one of the functions of our government. He must obtain his domestic charts from the Department of Commerce, his foreign charts from the Navy Department, and his nautical almanac from the Naval Observatory—and he will in some circumstances get sailing directions from the Army."

PEDANTS ARE REBUKED

Teachers of English who cling to all the ancient rules were given a thorough-going rebuke in a recent lecture by Dr. Frank H. Vizel, one of the greatest living authorities and editor of a leading dictionary.

Among other things, the doctor countenanced using a sentence with a preposition, as opposed to the split infinitive, testified to the forcefulness of moderate amount of slang, and otherwise played havoc with many pet traditions of the pedants.

The rules and usages sanctioned by the most virile writers and speakers will constitute the highest authority in any particular period.

EARNEST YOUNG PEOPLE

In spite of all the loose talk and writing about the wild youth of the present day, recent statistics from the Bureau of Education indicate that the percentage of earnest young people is still very high.

These statistics show that one-half of the young men and one-fourth of the young women in the colleges and universities of the United States are earning their schooling in whole or part through working outside of school hours. In one year more than \$33,000,000 was earned by the labor of students.

Among the part time jobs held by students are office work, automobile repairing, specialty selling, teaching, hotel and summer resort employment, household service, farm work and other activities.

In the face of such a showing as is being made, it can hardly be maintained that the young generation is as frivolous as its critics would have us believe.

NEWS FOR BANDITS

Some very good news came out of Moore, Okla., a little town near Oklahoma City, last week. That is, it was good news for law-abiding folk, but bad news for bandits.

When two suspicious-looking characters were observed riding about the town, bank officials dressed armfuls of bread to be stashed in a back room. Shortly the suspects entered and ordered Otto Hayes, bookkeeper, "stick 'em up." Hayes didn't do anything of the kind. He knocked one down as one of the guards got into action, killing one bandit, and perhaps fatally wounding the other.
