### SOME LONG WORDS

What is the longest word in the English language? That is a hard question to answer, as writers have from time to time coined words of greater length which have never been taken into general use.

The longest in Webster's International dictionary is honorificabilitudinitatibus, defined as "honorable," a pedantic nonsense word, used by Shakespeare in "Love's Labour Lost," and containing 27 letters.

But in chemical treatises may be found even longer words, more wonderfully compounded than the chemical products which they describe. For example, tetrahydro-*para*-methoxyquinone, with 31 letters, also para-*tert*-butylmethoxybenzene on 30 letters, and others.

English must yield the palm to some foreign languages, however, when long words are considered. In German, schutzengrabenherrnverhängungautomobile, with 35 letters, is as formidable as the war engine it describes. This machine is commonly designated by the four letter word "tunk," a saving of 31 letters going to the credit of our mother tongue.

Longest of all so far discovered is a Greek word of 181 letters, which appropriately enough is the name of a dial containing many ingredients. We call it simply "hash."

Out of course, the longest word we do not speak out the Greek word here. We have already given him and the prosector a worthy one-day!

### THE DESTRUCTIVE RAY

Public health authorities estimate that the actual loss caused by rats in the United States amounts to \$400,000,000 a year, of which about one-half is in foodstuffs and the rest in the destruction of other property.

The number of rats engaged in these depredations is estimated at 120,000,000, or about equal to the country's human population.

Besides the destructiveness of the rat is its constant menace to health through the transmission of disease, especially bubonic plague, which is spread entirely by fleas which infest infected rats. While the disease has been held in check in countries employing preventive measures, bubonic plague kills about 11,000,000 people in India during a 20-year period.

The Public Health Service declares that if the extraordinarily prolific breeding of rats were not partially controlled by natural enemies, disease and the cannibalistic tendencies of the animal itself, they would soon overrun the world and exterminate man by depriving him of all food.

Life, man's other environmental menace to property and health, the rat appears to be taken for granted, and seldom is any concerted effort made with a view to its extermination.

### PREACHER NOW GENERAL

One day a preacher, the next day a major-general in the Army: Sounds like fiction, but it is a fact, and a remarkable occurrence in the life of Reverend and Major, General George G. Everson, new chief of the militia bureau in the War Department at Washington.

General Everson, now 50 years old, served as a private in the Spanish-American war, became a Baptist minister in 1901, was a pastor in four states, always interested in military affairs and long identified with the National Guard. He was a captain in Infantry during the World War, and until 1919 was a adjutant general of the Indiana National Guard, in addition to being pastor of the First Baptist church of Muncie, for which his ability as an organizer has produced a \$35,000 edifice as well as leadership in spiritual affairs.

When General Hoover appointed him to the War Department post his colleagues made him pastor emeritus, refusing to let him resign. As head of the militia bureau General Everson will be responsible for the organization, training and equipment of all

National Guard units. After getting settled at his new desk, he said:

"I'll probably be called a hypocrite for leaving the pulpit to take this job. One fellow wrote me I'd go to hell if he did. But he's right, but the road won't be long."

### TO AID CHORUS GIRLS

An unusual philanthropic enterprise is being carried on by the Barrington High School staff and author, who in addition to a competency earned through her art has recently inherited half a million dollars from an uncle in Australia.

### GAS DANGER IN GARAGE

We frequently hear in press dispatches of someone drowning death from carbon monoxide gas from the exhaust of his automobile, usually in a closed garage.

Warnings concerning this danger have been issued by the Public Health Service. Especially in the colder sections of the country are these accidents likely to happen, where drivers sometimes let the engine run for hours to warm up, before driving out of the garage.

The smallest engine will give off enough carbon monoxide gas in two or three minutes to make the air of an ordinary garage dangerous, while larger engines will naturally dominate the air in less time.

It is recommended that you open a garage door on the red coals produced by the gas, it causes death by paralysis of the respiratory organs. While the victim loses consciousness gradually, he may be paralyzed to such an extent that he is unable to escape, when the time he becomes aware of his danger, the time he becomes aware of his danger.

The only safe plan is to avoid running an automobile engine at all in any place not well ventilated.
