COLD GERM IS FOUND

The long-sought germ that causes the common cold has been found at last, according to the claim of Dr. Pfeiffer of the Maryland University School of Medicine, who has been on the trail of the elusive pest for seven years.

What is still more important, if it proves true, is that he has developed a vaccine which destroys the germ and thus cures the cold in short order. Dr. Pfeiffer's method will be further tested by physicians of Johns Hopkins, and the results are awaited with interest.

The importance of such a discovery will be understood by everyone, because few persons are exempt from the discomfort and often serious consequences which arise from "catching cold." It is estimated that the value of time lost from work in America industry on account of common colds is not less than two billion dollars a year.

So, if Dr. Pfeiffer has really found a scientific method of preventing this suffering and waste, he will be entitled to high rank among the benefactors of mankind.

SPREAD KING'S DEATH

Admirers of daredevil speed enthusiasts will keenly regret the tragic death of Major Henry O. Seagrave, who died from injuries received when he was thrown from his speedboat, which overturned on Lake Lindermeir, England, on his unlucky Friday, the 13th, while making more than 100 miles an hour.

Major Seagrave was 34 years old and his life had been filled with adventure. As an

aviator during the World war was shot down by the Germans, but was survived. On March 11, 1929, he drove a 100-mile 231 miles an hour at Daytona Beach, Fla., setting a record that still stands, and for which he was knighted by King George.

On the day of his death he attained a speed record of 101 miles an hour, beating the former world's record of 93 miles, held by Gar Wood of Detroit. Not satisfied, he made another attempt for still greater speed, and in this effort he lost his life.

The consummate gift of Major Seagrave was illustrated in his last moments. When taken from the water he was unconscious, he said if his two mechanics were safe, then he hoped into coma and died. It happened that one mechanic drowned, while the other was saved, although suffering a broken thigh, and was still conscious.

While we may question the soundness of a speed demon's judgment, his recklessness can not fail to excite our admiration.
