## WHAT'S GOING ON IN WASHINGTON

The federal government, in the guise of Santa Claus, is tremendously active at this holiday, preparing to distribute four billions of dollars and more in presents and promises of presents. At the same time, congress, which keeps the national gift bill filled, will be asked, according to plan now framed, to add two more billions or even three billions, to the funds which are counted on to make the Christmas and the next Christmas merrier.

Those remembered by Uncle Sam's billions include more than 3,000,000 farmers, 4,000,000 unemployed, and another million or more who are the public works. How many more millions are being affected by indirect remembrances from Washington is undetermined. But 1,000,000 cotton farmers, 1,500,000 corn and soybean farmers, 900,000 wheat farmers, and thousands of tobacco farmers are promised \$120,000,000 in individual checks during the month ahead. And more 4,000,000 formerly unemployed are getting each week checks from the treasury of the United States, paying them for civil works. A plan of 100,000 checks will turn out about \$750,000,000 to this Christmas. Harold I. Ives, public works administrator, reports that about 4,000,000 formerly unemployed are getting checks that have their date in Washington.

Starting its part toward making the big Christmas outlay a success, the treasury on November 21st paid out \$60,000,000. In fact, presents from the nation's capital are flowing out at the rate of \$2,000,000 a day. That makes about \$200,000,000 a day. The spending is to be speeded up even further. The farmers are getting their billion and more, but only on condition that they cut down their production and try to put their house in order. States and cities have their billions.
