## Statement of Edward A. Brown

"Because there has appeared in the press and otherwise certain statements made by my political opponents and by persons advocating the candidacy of other candidates for the office of sheriff, it seems proper that at this time I should address myself to my fellow citizens of Lake County.

"I am announcing here and now that I will be a candidate for the Republican nomination for the office of sheriff.

"My appeal for the Republican nomination is directed to all members of the party who are interested in good government, in the efficient and honest management of this important office, and in the nomination of a candidate who can and will be certain of triumph in November.
