A 24 hour check on traffic made by men from the Illinois Department of Public Highways at the Main and Hough street intersection Friday and Saturday rowealed 11,136 care and trucks was done for eight hours Friday from 7 a. m. to 11 a. m. and from 2 p. m. until 4 p. m. Saturday's count was for 16 consecutive hours from 7 a. m. until 11 p. m. Friday, 252 care and 655 trucks were tabulated for a total of 2918.
