

Methodist Quintet Wins Church League Basketball Championship

Defeats St. Anne in Final Game on Regular Schedule

Baptists Finish Second; To Start Annual Tourney Monday Night

In their final regular schedule game, Monday night, the Methodist quintet defeated St. Anne, 24 to 14, and in so doing won the 1935-36 church league basketball championship.

This victory gave the Methodists a season record of seven victories and a single defeat—the defeat coming in their opening game with the Baptists, who finished in second place with six wins and one loss.

Winning of this year's title by the Methodist team was the outcome of the league, St. Paul's championship last year (1934-35), and the year before that with Salem crown.

The loss of several outstanding players weakened the St. Anne team and this year it ended in second place. St. Anne's record in a tie for fourth and fifth places in the standing.

Last Monday's game were the final ones on the regular schedule. The church tournament will continue to finish that the season.

Accuracy of the free throw line helps the Methodists to its victory over St. Anne. The Methodists missed three out of 13 attempts.

The rapidly improving St. Paul quintet defeated Salem, 28 to 19, in the final game of the regular season.

The fourth annual church tournament will get underway next Monday night with St. Paul meeting St. Anne in the first game, and Salem and the Methodists playing in the second.

The winner of the St. Paul contest will meet the Baptists, March 2, and the winner of that game will meet the St. Paul-St. Anne winner for the trophy championship, March 9.

In an effort to give weaker teams a better chance an extra tournament was added this year. Smaller teams first will meet in a district tournament, the winner and runner-up of each to qualify for the regional. Larger teams will automatically draw a complete bye in the district, competing in the regional and then in the sectionals if they win their regional.

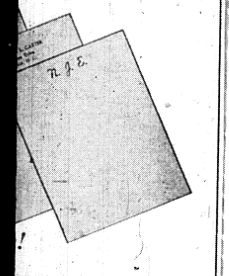
