Edward J. Barrett, state auditor announced a 10 per cent payment to depositors of the closed First State bank of Barrington this week amounting to \$28,275.33. The checks were mailed out Friday.

1100 Depositors Receive 10 Per Cent Payment; 40 Per Cent Repaid

At the same time, the Cheltenham Trust and Savings bank and the Sherman State bank also paid dividends to depositors. The Sherman State bank paid out \$12,421.31 to 1500 depositors, which is 10 percent of the claims. The Cheltenham Trust and Savings bank repaid \$13,448.43 to 3200 depositors, which is five per cent of the claims. The payment of the Barrington depositors was the largest.
