Only Troop in N. W. Suburban Council to Own a Ship

A beautiful sailboat, 22 feet long and with an \$5 foot canvas arched for them Friday, a gift from their sponsor, Jewel Tea company. It will be sailed on the Jewel lagoon until the boys learn how to operate it safely and then will be transferred to Lake Zurich. About three weeks of work is necessary before it can be launched.

At the time of launching, Scout Executive Keiger of this district will present a sea scout charter to the Barrington troop. There are 20 sea scouts in the village.

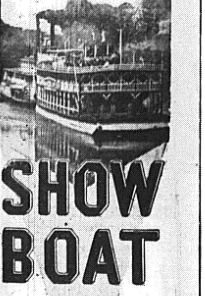
