HITLER AND THE TREATY OF VERSAILLES

Since the close of the first World war there has been a constant struggle between the elements endeavoring to introduce a measure of law and justice into international relations, and those content to place reliance in the traditional method of unrestricted force.

The Treaty of Versailles, unquestionably justified in many of its punitive clauses, was foredoomed by an intolerable mistake. It attempted to keep Germany in permanent and humiliated subjection to her conquerors.

This essential condition is a mutual acceptance of the commitments in the first instance exacted from the defeated nation alone. Such commitments with regard to disarmament were accepted—but never fulfilled—by the victorious parties to the Treaty of Versailles.
