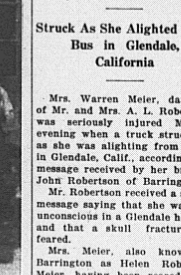
Four Barringtonians Listed in 1936-7 "Who's Who" Book
